Ghosts or Spirits?

According to folklore, a ghost is the soul or spirit of a deceased person or animal that can appear, in visible form or other manifestation, to the living. The mode of manifestation can vary widely, and range from an invisible presence, translucent or wispy shapes, to realistic, life-like visions. Ghosts are generally described as solitary essences that haunt specific locations, objects, though stories of phantom armies, ghost trains, phantom ships, and even ghost animals have also been recounted.

While it may be that warps, fields, wormholes and vortices can provide conduits for alien civilizations, and crypto-beasties, they are most likely also the mechanism that allows other manifestations to interact in our world from adjacent universes, or other dimensions of space and or time. Also, some areas tend to be far more active than others. Why would this be so? First of all, not every location may be “haunted”. Also we need to take into account external factors such as the variances of the Earth’s magnetic field, space weather conditions, cosmic ray bombardment, inconsistencies in the Earth’s Geomagnetic shield, underlying rock strata that creates unusual geomagnetic activity, and other factors which in turn causes reality or our perception of it to respond differently. There are some researchers out there who attribute this to distortions in the laws of physics. On the contrary, I believe these things occur because of the laws of physics. You folks who believe differently need to go back to school and specifically study not just physics, but quantum mechanics. A road map is required to navigate the twists and turns the highway takes as it winds its way through Quantumville. In fact, we aren’t even sure what a ghost is. We have a folkloric definition, but a physical definition has eluded us. But we do know something about the mechanics of these apparitions or effects. We know that ghostly activity is related to abnormal unexplainable electromagnetic activity. We have also discovered that this EMF is emergent, or that it appears in our environment from no apparent source. Also associated with these events at an extremely localized area associated with it, is time anomalies, gravitational fluctuations, elevated ion counts, temperature fluctuations, gamma radiation bursts, varying levels of ultraviolet light, elevated static charges, magnetic anomalies, and increases in air conductance. We have postulated that these may not be created by the “haunts” themselves, rather by the conduit that facilitates this interaction. We have also hypothesized that apparitions may be the result of energy projection and holographic boundaries associated with wormhole formation. But what are ghosts really?

Let’s examine what we have been led to believe through subjective experiences.

We always want to associate ghostly activity with an afterlife, or with a formerly living being, but in all honesty, there is no direct evidence that this is so. While we certainly have a voluminous amount of anecdotal evidence that would suggest that this is true, empirical evidence is lacking. The truth is, we don’t KNOW what they are, we only believe they are what we believe them to be. It may very well turn out they they are something “completely different”. Ghosts tend to be associated with the past, meaning they are usually a manifestation of a person or thing that existed in the past, no longer exists as a living entity in this world, and somehow are able to affect the present in some mysterious manner. To me this screams out “time travel”, and the ability to cross from one point in space/time to another. Nothing weird here, Einstein tells us that

wormholes can connect space, time, and/or spacetime. So let's explore a theory here, and entertain me for a moment. We are made up, as living beings, of millions of impulses, signals, EMF radiations, and other forms of energy. What if, when we die, we do not violate the laws of energy conservation (energy can be neither created nor destroyed, but it can be converted into another form) and we radiate outwards as pure energy, into space, time, or spacetime? Or what if a wormhole opens and provides us with a conduit to enter into a universe devoid of matter, but existing as pure energy? Talk about a bright light at the end of the tunnel....

At any rate, then what if we maintained the totality of our consciousness, being able to think, and apply logic, much like we were able to do as living, breathing organic life forms? If this were the case, then it isn't much of a stretch to conceive that visitation of those who came before us could be not only possible, but perhaps a regular occurrence. Time and distance would not be a factor if a wormhole was at the heart of these effects.

Residual Haunts

Then there is the curious case of "residual haunts" or what some colorfully call "Imprints", which do not appear to be aware of what is going on in our reality even though they are interacting with it. They seem oblivious to the observer. Imprints often repeat the same tasks over and over, as if they were residual memories recorded at a particular place in the environment. In the terminology of ghost hunting, residual hauntings, are repeated playbacks of auditory, visual, olfactory, and other sensory phenomena that are attributed to a traumatic event, life-altering event, or a routine event of a person or place, like an echo or a replay of a videotape of past events. Ghost hunters and related paranormal television programs say that a residual haunting, unlike an intelligent haunting, does not directly involve a spiritual entity aware of the living world and interacting with or responding to it. One of the first to promulgate the hypothesis of residual haunting was Thomas Charles Lethbridge, in books such as *Ghost and Ghoul*, written in 1961. The subject was explored in Peter Sasdy's 1972 television play *The Stone Tape*, written by Nigel Kneale and aired on the BBC. The popularity of the program with our neighbors "across the pond" has led to residual haunting becoming known colloquially as the "Stone Tape theory."

Once I believe that this could be an event recorded by the Zero Point Field, and stored there, in what Edgar Cayce referred to as the Akashic records. If you have read Cayce, he believed the Akashic records held every thought, memory, action and thing. So then, if these type of manifestations are recorded on the ZPF, then psychics who can see ghosts have the ability to tap into the ZPF and witness these occurrences. But my belief has changed, based on data. What if, these residual events weren't stored information at all, but instead the witnessing of the actual event in the time as it is occurring? If this is facilitated by a wormhole, we may be watching the holographic boundary, much like an old movie on TV, and literally seeing history as it happens, by viewing a specific point in spacetime. Mediums may get their information from a localized wormhole that is a conduit for a low frequency EMF carrier that has information in the form of a holographic "movie" of the event, whether it is from the past or the future. So it may be that a "ghost" is a manifestation of pure consciousness onto a holographic boundary. As

a bonus, when these wormholes connect, in some cases we can look back in time. So while we can't fully define what a ghost is scientifically...yet...we can define what a haunting is.
